We hope you enjoy your experience at the platform and the platform administrators, along with our international Biobord Contact Points, are ready to assist you in getting the most out of the services available.



MY MESSAGES

Messages in Biobord work as a private messaging service between Biobord users and user groups. Messages can be sent to individual user tags or group tags.

Messages is a part of the Forum functionalities, but you can access 'My Messages easily also from your 'Login' list (see picture below).





You can also access the messages via Forum under your profile icon.

When you have entered Messages, you can find from the left sidebar:

Inbox Arrived messages

Sent Messages that you have sent

Archive Messages that you have archived



Group messages send with a group tag

(You only see group messages of groups you are member of)


How to Send a Message?

When you have entered Messages, you can find 'New Message' button from the left side of the page.

Follow these steps to send a message:

1. Press 'New Message'

- New Message
- Add a user with a @usename tag.You can also use some of the group tags for messaging.
- **3.** Add a topic to your message in the field that says 'What is this discussion about in one brief sentence?'
- **4.** Write your message. You can use same content editing tools as in the forum.
- 5. Press 'Message' from the bottom to send the message





When you receive a Message, you can find a reply button below the message as shown in the picture below.








Set the message to bookmarks

How to Manage the Messages?

To archive or manage many messages at once, follow these steps for bulk actions:

1. Click list icon on top of the message list



- 2. Tick a box in front of the message(s) that you wish to archive
- **3.** On the right side of the page, a wrench icon appears




- **4.** You are able to select different bulk actions that will affect the selected messages:
 - Archive Topics
- Move to Inbox
- Notifications
- · Reset Read

What are Drafts?

From Drafts, the user can access unfinished topics, replies and messages.

When a user starts composing a reply in any topic or a message and does not finalize or publish it, the text will be autosaved as a new draft.

You can find the 'Drafts' under your 'Activity' or by clicking your profile icon in the forum as shown in the picture below.

OPEN FORUM

Biobord Forum consists of several categories for discussion. Each category has a specific purpose that is defined in the category description (About the category -topic). You can check this topic by clicking the pinned 'About the category' topics listed on top of the category. In the Forum, there are both open and closed categories. The closed categories have limited access to certain groups of users and are not visible to other users in the forum. You can study the user groups at https://forum.biobord.eu/g and request a right to join interesting groups.

In the forum, you can identify the closed categories from the lock icon.

However, please note that you only see the categories that you have access to, so most closed categories are not visible to you.


The forum can be viewed in category view (default setting) or in the 'Latest' view. When you select the 'Latest' view, you can see the most recent content posted on the Forum from all categories that you have access to. You can select the 'Category' view or the 'Latest' view from the top of the Forum page. Please note also that when you enter a certain category, the view changes and you only see the topics of that category. You can return the main forum view e.g. from the head banner.

The Biobord forum offers open services available for all registered users.

These include user support at 'Biobord User Support', networking and matchmaking at the 'Open Biobord Forum' as well as access to online events via 'Biobord On Stage'.




Biobord User Support
