About

- Biobord is an online platform for bioeconomy innovations, knowledge sharing, discussion and networking
- It aims to create international discussion about bioeconomy topics and bring bioeconomy developers together around the Baltic Sea Region to solve joint problems

This guide helps you to start using Biobord – from registration to finding the right topics!



Registration

 You can login from all the tabs by using the 'Log in' button on the right top corner



Registration

- When you open the 'Forum' tab, you see all the open groups
- From this tab you do the registration and logging in



Registration is completely free

and without obligation!

You have two options when you sign up:



- If you choose to create a new account, press the 'Register' button
 - → Fill in your information
 - Verify your account from the email you gave
 - → Log in to Biobord

! Note that the confirmation email might end up to the trash folder in your email, so remember to check it after your registration

• When you have created and verified your account, you are ready to use Biobord!

Your profile

After logging in, you can adjust your profile

Click your initials/profile picture on the 'Forum' tab -> Click your nickname -> Choose preferences



We suggest you to...

- Add a profile picture it is nice to see who you are having a conversation with
- Add a short introduction to your profile
 - Who are you?
 - Where are you from?
 - What are your expertises?
 - Where can you be helpful?
 - What do you expect from Biobord?

 Add your own introduction to <u>Open Biobord -group</u>, so other users get to know you

Categories

Biobord has two types of groups:

- 1 Main categories: User Support, Open Biobord and Biobord On Stage
- Biobord User Support (ENG): User guides, tutorials and tips. Share your questions and feedback here, and the Biobord Staff will answer.
- Open Biobord Forum (ENG):

International meeting place for bioeconomy developers, you can look for expertise, partners or talented professionals for a project or business venture and you are welcome to share your expertise and introduce yourself at the Forum. It is also a perfect place to joint ventures and actions.

- Biobord On Stage (ENG): Announcement area for bioeconomy themed webinars, for example for innovation presentation. We offer you web event platform, bioeconomy expert audience and communication channel.
- 2 **Project groups and regional groups**
- These groups can be set up by anyone with the help of admin
- Each project group has description of its content and contact person in the 'About' topic

Creating a topic

- Creating a topic requires you to be logged in, offline you can only read topics
- Choose a category for your topic, in this example Open Biobord Forum
- You find the +New Topic –button on the right
- Text editing window appears, and you can start to compose your text. You see a preview of your draft on the right.

Tags

- Tags help you to search and recognise the topics that interest you
- Each tag has an icon, so it is easy to see what the topic is about
- Adding tags to your topic:
 - click the 'Optional tags' on your text editing window
 - either choose from the suggested tags that are most used, or write the tag and then choose it

Please see the updated tag list on Biobord User Support category, and feel free to suggest new tags at HelpDesk!

- There are 6 main tag-categories and more specific tags under them
- We suggest you to add both: general tag and more specific tag

You have two options when you want to search a tag

Click the 'Search' button and type in the tag you want to search with The results show topics that have your word in them, or you can click the tag on the right and it shows you all the topics with the tag

Sending a private message

You can send a private message to a person by clicking their name or profilepicture, and then clicking 'Message'

Chat

- Sending a private message works also from the chat, which is on the right bottom corner of the forum
- However, the chat feature doesn't send a notification to email about receiving a message
